Message from Tammy Steckbauer (Principal)

December 6, 2016, PTO Minutes

Members present: Tammy Steckbauer, Jill Brillhart, Roxi Denzine, Deb Albee, Kim Zdroik, Tamara Sillars and Emily Gaffney

Principal's Report: Mrs. Steckbauer congratulated and thanked Rib Mountain staff and families for achieving 89.3- "*Significantly Exceeds Expectations*" - on the school report card. She shared that this could only be achieved because the school and home both work so hard. Handwritten thank you notes by various students were also shared following the recent author visit by David LaRoche. Mrs. Steckbauer also shared the Rib staff's appreciation for PTO's financial support of this opportunity.

Parent resources were requested following November's PTO meeting and parent surveys taken recently, so three were shared. The first resource was a flyer for a course to be taught at Rib called *Parenting the Love and Logic Way* on six consecutive Wednesday evenings. Space is limited, so don't delay in registering.

Teacher's Report: Mrs. Albee shared the staff's thanks and appreciation for the amazing meals provided by PTO for parent teacher conference nights. She also shared that as a school, our PBIS focus for this month is "*Mustang Manners*", and that we are working on social manners in common areas like the hallway or lunchroom. In addition, when our Mustang Meter goal is met, our next all school acknowledgement will be a *fancy dining experience* in which staff will dress up and serve warm cookies to all students at lunch. Finally, Mrs. Albee inquired as to whether or not the PTO has in the past or would be interested in the future in purchasing milk cards for students in need. This was discussed with the idea to use money raised from the Milk Caps program for this purpose.

President's Report: Tamara Sillars shared her thanks and appreciation for all who have volunteered their time for PTO.

Treasurer's Report: Jill Brillhart shared that the current balance of \$5,141.49 does not include the profits realized following the *My Local Deals* coupon book fundraiser. PTO expects to raise between \$3,000.00 and \$4,000.00 from that fundraiser. The Fall bazaar was also a huge success earning a profit of \$1,648.28 for the organization.

My Local Deals Coupon Book Fundraiser: The fundraiser is wrapping up with some final housekeeping to be completed. Anyone who sold 3 or more books will be receiving a bag compliments of PTO. PTO covered the cost of \$3.00 each.

Crossing Guard Appreciation Week-Jan.16-20, 2017: In honor of Adult Crossing Guard Week, PTO will again be purchasing \$20 gift cards from Bigby Coffee to be presented to the 4 adult crossing guards who serve our students at Robin Lane & Rib Mountain Drive, Robin Lane & Hummingbird, as well as North Mountain Road & Partridge.

Upcoming Events/Volunteer Opportunities:

The Decade Dance scheduled for Friday, Feb.17, will require expectations to be shared in advance with families and students alike. Specifically, parents/guardians will need to attend the dance with their children. It is not permissible to drop off children and leave. Secondly, expectations regarding proper disposal of garbage will be discussed along with behavior expectations for students in the hallway and gym. It was discussed that decorating the gym with some artificial trees and lights would provide enough light for supervision without negatively affecting the environment. Snacks and drinks were discussed with the idea of providing tickets or some way to stamp students as they receive their refreshments. Adults will need be stationed at different hallways to prevent access and improve safety. A basket raffle will once again be held at the end of the evening.

The Sq1Art fundraiser was discussed. Mrs. Steckbauer will check with Rib's art teacher, Ms. Mikul, and share feedback regarding this as a possible spring fundraiser much like last year.

Spirit Wear: Mrs. Zdroik shared some information regarding different vendors and pricing packages and will continue to search for the best possible opportunities.

Cookbook Fundraiser: Mrs. Zdroik shared a fundraiser opportunity held at GD Jones about six years ago. She shared sample cookbooks, the actual cookbook Jones' families created, as well as a pricing guide. Mrs. Albee shared that it's been a number of years since Rib created a cookbook.

Future PTO Meetings: PTO meetings will continue to be held on the first Tuesday of the month at 6:15 pm. The remaining dates are as follows: Jan.3, Feb. 7, March 7, April 4, and May 2.

When should I keep my child home from school ~ WHEN

- Vomiting or diarrhea: more than one episode in 24 hours
- Fever - temperature greater than 100.5, child must be fever free, without medication, for 24 hours before returning to school
- Strep throat - student must be kept home until culture is read. If positive student should remain home until 24 hours of antibiotics treatment is completed.

If your child has a medical condition that requires medication either **over the counter or prescription**, please complete a medication consent form to allow Health Office personnel to administer the medication. Prescription medications must have a consent form signed by the physician, as well as the parent. Also, all medication **MUST** be brought to school by a parent and in the original container. If your child has any health concerns, including food allergies, asthma, or severe allergies, please advise your child's teacher along with our Health Aide, Mrs. Sadie Trapp via email at strapp@wausauschools.org or phone 715-261-0220.

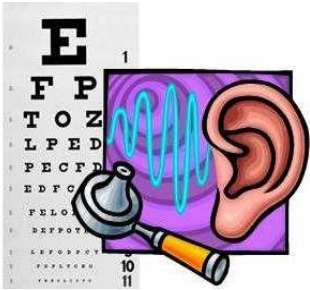

This is true for every grade - elementary, middle school, and high school students.

Parents, it is important to have your child/ren at school by 8:35 AM as this is when attendance and lunch counts are taken.

8:15 AM - Supervision on the playground begins

8:30 AM - Bell rings for students to enter the building

8:35 AM - Announcements/Instructional day begins

1. Please call the office by 9:00 AM if your child is ill. After this time if there is no call, the school will contact you.
2. Students arriving after 9:00 AM will be marked absent for 1/2 day. If medical documentation is provided, it will be changed to medical.
3. If a student leaves more than 30 minutes before the end of the day, they are considered absent for 1/2 day. Medical appointments are excused if upon return to school (or the next day) documentation is provided of such appointments. At that time, the absence will be changed from 1/2 day absent to medical.
4. Please call or email the teacher along with Mrs. Lenzner, or leave a message on the school voice mail if your child will be absent due to illness, vacation, or medical appointments.

PLAN FOR - SCHOOL CLOSING

Media Announcement - ALL WAUSAU PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS WILL BE CLOSED TODAY

1. Schools **WILL NOT** be open for instruction.
2. Students **ARE NOT** to report.
3. Teachers, secretaries/ aides, and school nutrition staff (who work less than calendar year) **DO NOT** report to their respective schools.
4. Custodians and maintenance staff are to report to their respective work areas, or as assigned by the Director of Buildings and Grounds, as soon as safety will allow.
5. Calendar year staff assigned to the following locations will report to work as soon as safety allows: Longfellow Administration Center, East and West High Schools, Horace Mann and John Muir Middle Schools, and Maintenance and Operations Building (MOB).
6. All extra-curricular and evening activities will be canceled.

PLAN FOR - YELLOW SCHOOL BUS DELAY
