Rib Winter Concert Details

Wednesday, December 7, is Rib Mountain's winter concert to be held in Wausau West's auditorium beginning at **6:00 pm**. Doors generally open one hour before the program, and supervision will be available for students beginning at 5:30 pm.

Parents/families should arrive at West and plan to drop off their children at their designated classroom before the concert begins. PLEASE do not leave your child unattended/drop off at any classroom until greeted there by a Rib Mountain staff member. All staff will be arriving around 5:30 pm.

Students will be asked to remain with their teacher and classmates until it is their time to be on stage as well as after their performance. This will allow as many open seats as possible in the auditorium for family and friends wishing to attend.

While we hope you will be able to stay for the entire concert, we understand that this may not be possible with young families. We've structured the program to assist, and students will be performing in this order: K-1, 2-3, and 4-5.

Wausau West has graciously offered five different classrooms for our use before and during the program. Your children may leave their coats and boots in these designated classrooms:

Room 102-directly across from auditorium doors-Kdn. & Gr.5 Clark

Room 103-directly across from auditorium doors-Gr.1 & Gr.5 Fischer

Room 141-Near **front** entrance to West-go right (auditorium is to the left)-Gr.4

Room 164-Near **back** entrance to West-go left (auditorium is to the right)-Gr.3

Room 162-Near **back** entrance to West-go left (auditorium is to the right)-Gr.2

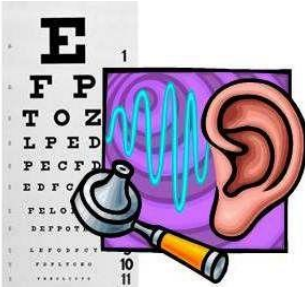

This will alleviate any safety issues with such a large crowd. Students are encouraged to "dress up" as this is a special night for them; however, please do not feel that you need to go shopping for a new outfit! Nice school clothes are very appropriate for such an event. Please keep in mind when choosing your child's attire that students will be walking and moving on risers, and that a crowded auditorium creates a very warm performance environment.

WINTER DRESS CODE

Winter is on the way as the forecast is for much colder weather in the coming weeks.

At Rib Mountain School, we have a Winter Dress Code as soon as the temperatures are below 40 and there is snow on the ground. Please note the following:

- **Students MUST WEAR BOOTS outside once there is snow on the ground.** If they want to play on the playground equipment and on the field, they **MUST** have snowpants on as well.
- If students choose **NOT** to wear boots, they will be required to stand against the wall at recess. If they choose to wear boots but not snow pants, they will be restricted to the black top area.
- It is also helpful to have waterproof mittens labeled with names. All clothing should be labeled if possible. An extra pair of socks in the backpack is helpful as well on those extra wet and slushy days.

We encourage hats and mittens, along with snowpants and boots, to be worn every day during the winter months.

EMERGENCY PLANS

PLAN FOR - SCHOOL CLOSING

Media Announcement - ALL WAUSAU PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS WILL BE CLOSED TODAY

1. Schools **WILL NOT** be open for instruction.
2. Students **ARE NOT** to report.
3. Teachers, secretaries/ aides, and school nutrition staff (who work less than calendar year) **DO NOT** report to their respective schools.
4. Custodians and maintenance staff are to report to their respective work areas, or as assigned by the Director of Buildings and Grounds, as soon as safety will allow.
5. Calendar year staff assigned to the following locations will report to work as soon as safety allows: Longfellow Administration Center, East and West High Schools, Horace Mann and John Muir Middle Schools, and Maintenance and Operations Building (MOB).
6. All extra-curricular and evening activities will be canceled.

PLAN FOR - YELLOW SCHOOL BUS DELAY

Media Announcement - WAUSAU PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS WILL BE OPEN AT THEIR REGULAR TIME. FIRST STUDENT (YELLOW BUSES) WILL BEGIN THEIR ROUTES ONE (1) OR TWO (2) HOURS LATE. ALL 4K AND EARLY CHILDHOOD CLASSES ARE CANCELED.

1. All 4K and Early Childhood classes are canceled. Teachers and support staff will report.
2. **ALL STAFF WILL REPORT** to their respective schools/buildings at the regular time.
3. Metro Ride (Express) buses will run routes at their regular time.
4. Students will report to their respective schools at the regular time unless they are riding a yellow bus.
5. Breakfast and school lunches will be served at the regular time.
6. School dismissal will be at the regular time.
