1. Principal's Report

 - c. Art Fair is May 11. Volunteers are needed (Unfortunately, none of the PTO officers present at the meeting are available to volunteer this day due to other obligations).
 - d. Spring Fling staff basket is being compiled (deadline May 26).

 - b. Food will be purchased from IGA and Sam's.
 - c. Tickets were discussed. Classroom basket raffle tickets will be sold early to students after school Tuesday (Tamara volunteering) and Wednesday (volunteer needed – Laural). All other raffle items will be only available for tickets to be purchased at the Spring Fling event. Signs will be posted indicating that tickets will only be sold until 6:00, and the raffle tickets will be drawn promptly at 6:15 p.m. We discussed whether or not winners needed to be present. It was decided that we wouldn't require the winners to be present, we will store and contact winners if they are not there at 6:15 for the drawing.
