We would like to thank our community for your consideration of the referendum question that appeared on the ballot Tuesday, April 5. We learned that the question was approved by a majority of voters.

As a result, the Wausau School District will move forward with addressing long-term facility needs across three main categories:

- 1. Safety & Security
- 2. Facility Systems & Deferred Maintenance
- 3. Right-sized Learning Spaces

Even with the approval of this referendum, property taxes are still projected to *decrease*.

- 15 Minutes: The work gets done faster when we all help! Set a timer for 15 minutes. Everyone pitches in to help clean the kitchen, pull weeds, do dishes, pick-up, etc. Using a small chunk of time where everyone helps makes the work go faster and keeps it "doable."

2022-2023 Registration for 4K Learning Academies and Community Sites

Begins February 1, 2022

Registration for the free, half-day 4K Program is a two-step process for all eligible children (Four years of age on or before September 1, 2022)

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Visit the 4K & Early Childhood page at www.wausauschools.org

Complete and submit the online form. You will receive an electronic confirmation following the completion of Step 1. The online registration indicates your interest in 4K and preferred site of attendance; however, the registration form must be verified (Step 2) before your child is fully registered and assigned to a site.


