iPad Insurance

Thank you for being diligent in returning the important forms to school with your student(s). We have received several iPad agreements that are marked "accept insurance", but the \$10 fee has not been received. You can send cash or a check payable to the Wausau School District. You also have the option to pay via the Infinite Campus Portal. If insurance is declined; families assume the full cost of any and all repairs caused by accident, misuse or abuse. Insurance does not cover lost items.



Updating Census Verifications

The district has implemented a new policy for updating census information. We will no longer be sending a paper copy home for you to make any changes. This will now be done in the **Parent Portal in Infinite Campus**. Even if there are no changes to your information, we are asking that you complete the process. It is suggested that you use a device other than your phone as it is much easier to navigate and you see more of the information.

It will prompt you to edit areas that may be missing information; this will be highlighted in yellow. If you forget to populate an area, it will be marked in red where the system is looking for an answer. You will save and move on to the next section. Please make sure to enter through <u>each</u> section and it will ask you to submit once all sections are complete. You will then receive an automated email when complete. If you do not have a parent portal, please see the information below.

Steps to setting up an Infinite Campus Account



- Go to the District's website, <u>www.wausauschools.org</u>
- Choose Families at the top of the page, then choose Parent-Portal-Infinite Campus Portal.
- Select Infinite Campus Parent Portal
- Select New User
- Enter the Activation Code to complete the registration.
- Create your own username and password.



Note From the Nurse

Snack Policy



Any snacks that will be eaten in the classroom must be nut-free. Individual student snacks may not be shared by another student.

Teachers may provide a store-bought, nut-free daily snack for all students. Parents may send in boxes of snacks for the class provided they are nut-free, store-bought, and labeled with ingredients. No homemade treats of any kind are allowed to be shared with the whole class. (Snacks for the individual student may be homemade.) Birthday treats shared with the class must be nut-free, store-bought, and labeled with ingredients. Peanut butter and other nuts may be eaten only in the cafeteria.

Illness

Keep your child home from school for:

- Vomiting or diarrhea more than one time in 24 hours. Keep home for 24 hours after last episode.
- Fever (temperature greater than 100.4 degrees.) Child must be fever-free without fever medicine for 24 hours before returning to school
- "Pinkeye" May remain in school if there is no fever and the child can avoid rubbing eyes.
- Strep throat. Keep home from school until throat culture is read and until 24 hours of antibiotic treatment is completed
- Lice. May return to school immediately after treatment with approved lice shampoo and no live lice are present.

Medications



All medicine to be given at school must be brought to school in the original bottle by a parent or other adult. A parent signature is required for over-the-counter medicine. A parent and a doctor signature are required for all prescription medicine.

Balloons

No Latex balloons are permitted in school.

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Your school nurses and health aides are here to help keep all students healthy and safe while they are at school. If you ever have any questions or concerns, please contact your school nurse.

Program Structure

3rd - 4th Grade

- Will Participate in Fall League prior to Traveling Season (Fall League is held at West)
- Traveling tournaments will not start until January
- Team Split evenly and all players play in every game as evenly as possible
- Will play in 4 to 5 tournaments (January/February), with possible scrimmages throughout the season

5th - 6th Grade

- 5th grade will be split evenly and all players will play in every game, playing time will not always be equal.
- 6th grade team creation will be based on player skill level, if teams can be split evenly they will be. Playing time will not always be equal. Creation of teams will be decided by the Wausau West coaching Staff.
- Will play in 6 8 tournaments

7th - 8th Grade

- Teams will be divided based on Skill/Ability. Teams determined by Wausau West coaching staff.
- Will play in 6 8 tournaments
- Traveling Season will begin after the John Muir Season. A tournament date or two may be played during the John Muir Season

<u>Practice Structure -</u> Practice is mandatory - Practices are held at schools on West side.

- Practice is 2 times per week. Practice days are either Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Thursday
- Practice time sessions are: 5:30pm 7:00pm and 7:00pm 8:30pm Younger Grades get the early slot.
