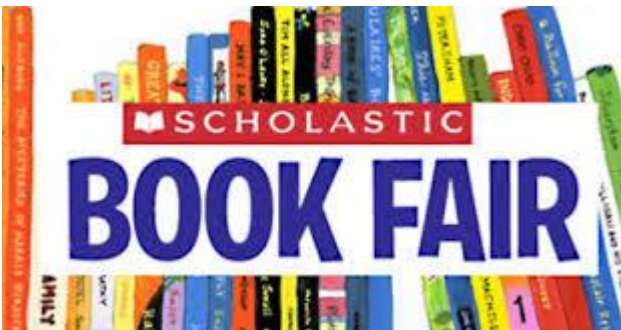

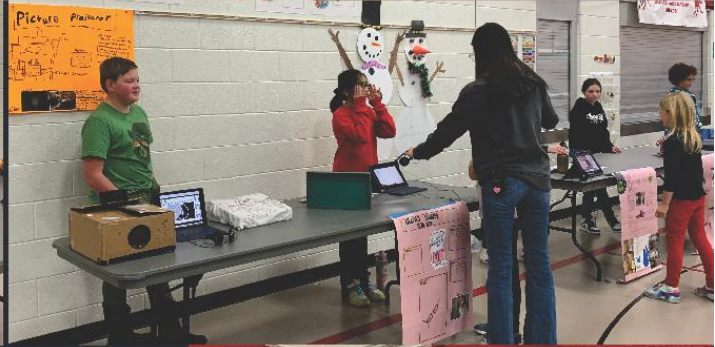
# 100<sup>th</sup> Day of School

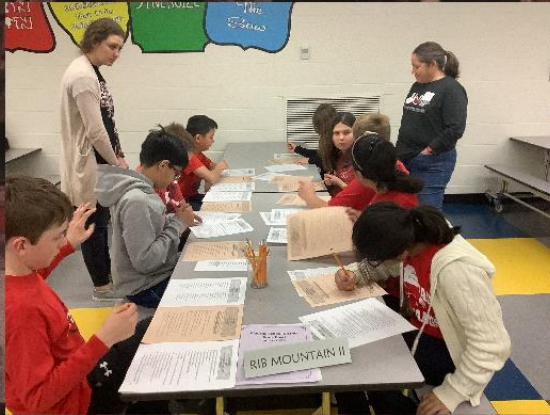

## Technology Reminder

This is just a friendly reminder to all of you that technology devices do not like being left in the cold, the heat or damp areas.



Leaving them in the cold will cause them to have different errors and issues. The battery will begin to die and the screens will begin to have issues as well. Bringing them into a warm room quickly after they are in the cold may cause condensation inside and also long term damage.

**In general - you will want to avoid leaving any technology devices in extreme temperatures (cold or heat) as much as possible.**
